3 (a) The objects to be pursued by the company on its incorporation are:

1. To provide economic, social, political, legal and cultural support to the society for the awareness and betterment of the challenges faced by the society, and to remove any discrepancies that is a challenge to the personal and professional growth of a society as a whole and to establish support system mechanism and ventures for their skill development also catering to mental health.
2. To help, develop, facilitate, promote, support the peoples and their families especially in the field of Health, education, social justice, equality and eradicate hunger, poverty, and malnutrition and promote health care, health camps, mobile medical vans, healthcare centers like hospitals and research Centre, sanitation and other facilities that is needed for leading a life of dignity and enhance their skills and opportunities by providing coordination and imparting training in the relevant skills and in entrepreneurship and help them in setting up self-employment ventures.
3. To facilitate, promote, serve, develop, provide,

campaign child development and women empowerment and promote gender and social equality in all the sections of society especially the marginalized to be encouraged and participate to their fullest potential in the art field. Encouraging, promoting, and developing various sports, games, and athletic activities for both professionals and amateurs.

4. To establish, develop, promote, franchise, study and training centers in India for conducting regular, weekday or weekend interactive classes and to get the necessary approval, permission required for this purpose and to enter in to Joint Venture, or collaborate with accredited educational and musical institutions in India to provide such infrastructure assistance to such accredited educational and musical institution and such other learning support on such terms and conditions as may be decided by the company from time to time.

5. To enhance occupational skills and technical knowledge of the neo- literates and individuals having basic school education. To raise efficiency, increase productive ability and enhance their livelihood opportunities. To identify and assist traditional/ modern skills in the field of art and culture through skilling/upskilling. To create master trainers who are eligible to work in a department/agency of skill development through training and orientation programs. Promoting sustainability, ecological balance, and environmental awareness.

6. To establish, setup, maintain, preserve and run in any part of India schools, colleges including medical

college and para medical college, coaching institutes, Study centers, oral coaching classes, online classes where in professional, technical, vocational or higher education and setup of university in field of art or any other type of education be imparted by conducting regular, part time classes for the personal and professional growth of the enrolled student and to establish new school i.e., play, nursery, primary, middle & High schools, colleges and non-profit universities/organizations based on different streams, modes, patterns, methods, specifications etc. and construction and development of Guest house.

7. To provide online and conventional facilities for prayers, rituals, rites, ceremonies, religious celebrations, and all other kinds of worship and expressions of faith, independently and in association with all kinds of religious organizations and institutions, including but not limited to, temples, churches, mosques, gurudwaras, synagogues, fire temples, derasars, monasteries, places of pilgrimage, religious trusts, and religious congregations of all kinds and aid and assist, with online and conventional services, all kinds of expressions of religious and spiritual faith by any person or persons in India

(b) *Matters which are necessary for furtherance of the objects specified in clause 3(a) are

1. To establish, maintain, and manage education and training centres, skill development institutes, career counselling cells, libraries, and community learning hubs to promote inclusive, equitable, and quality education for all.

2. To accept donations, contributions, grants, and aids (in cash or in kind) from individuals, government bodies,

corporate entities, philanthropic organizations, and international funding agencies in furtherance of the company's objectives.

3. To enter into collaborations, affiliations, agreements, or partnerships with government agencies, NGOs, academic institutions, research organizations, or private entities for the effective implementation of the company's mission.

4. To organize and conduct classes, workshops, seminars, webinars, training programs, conferences, competitions, and other educational and awareness events to disseminate knowledge and skills.

5. To develop, design, publish, and distribute educational materials such as books, journals, magazines, manuals, reports, and newsletters in both physical and digital formats.

6. To create and maintain online platforms, mobile applications, and learning management systems (LMS) for delivering e-learning, virtual mentorship, and academic support services.

7. To conduct educational research, surveys, assessments, and evaluation studies to understand and improve the learning needs and outcomes of various target groups.

8. To produce educational content including videos, podcasts, animations, infographics, and other multimedia content to support and enhance the learning process.

9. To procure and utilize technological tools, hardware, and software to facilitate digital education, virtual classrooms, and technology-enabled learning initiatives.

10. To engage and appoint employees, trainers, consultants, educators, mentors, researchers, volunteers, and other personnel necessary for achieving the objects of the company.

11. To establish, manage, support, or collaborate with schools, training institutes, health centres, mobile clinics, ambulance services, and other institutions aligned with the objects of the company.

12. To raise resources through lawful means such as membership fees, subscriptions, fundraising events, crowdfunding campaigns, and income from permitted activities under applicable laws.

13. To acquire, purchase, lease, hire, or construct movable and immovable property including land, buildings, educational equipment, and other assets required for conducting educational and social welfare activities.

14. To facilitate bridge courses and continuing education programs for school dropouts, working youth, and adult learners to promote lifelong learning.

15. To conduct career counselling, aptitude testing, and placement assistance services, especially for students and youth from disadvantaged and underrepresented communities.

16. To promote inclusive education through support for learners with disabilities, gender-sensitive pedagogy, and the development of culturally and linguistically appropriate educational resources.

17. To collaborate with companies under Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR)

initiatives for implementing joint educational, vocational, and community development programs.

18. To obtain certifications, licenses, affiliations, and accreditations from competent authorities, boards, or councils for conducting recognized courses, training, and assessments.

19. To create and maintain databases or repositories of educational materials, beneficiary data, research findings, feedback reports, and program impact evaluations.

20. To organize inter-school, inter-institutional, and community-level competitions, exhibitions, and creative learning activities to foster innovation, collaboration, and holistic development.

21. To ensure compliance with all applicable legal, tax, and regulatory frameworks, including but not limited to the provisions under the Income Tax Act, Foreign Contribution Regulation Act (FCRA), and the Goods and Services Tax (GST) Act.

22. To do all such other lawful acts, deeds, and things as may be incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above-mentioned objects or any one of them.

23. To develop and implement inclusive education modules specifically designed for children with special needs or disabilities, and to train educators in their effective use.

24. To conduct public engagement programs such as awareness campaigns, street plays, interactive community initiatives, and outreach activities promoting literacy, lifelong learning, and social

inclusion.

25. To establish helplines, mobile units, and support desks to provide counselling services, career advice, mental health support, and redressal of grievances related to education and training.

Provided that the company shall not support with its funds, or endeavor to impose on, or procure to be observed by its members or others, any regulation or restriction which, as an object of the company, would make it a trade union.

(iii) No remuneration or other benefit in money or money's worth shall be given by the company to any of its members, whether officers or members of the company or not, except payment of out-of-pocket expenses, reasonable and proper interest on money lent, or reasonable and proper rent on premises let to the company.

(iv) Nothing in this clause shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its officers or servants (not being members) or to any other person (not being member), in return for any services actually rendered to the company.

(v) Nothing in these clauses (iii) and (iv) shall prevent the payment by the company in good faith of prudent remuneration to any of its members in return for any services (not being services of a kind which are required to be rendered by a member), actually rendered to the company
